

Quick Guide for Teachers: How to Open SENict Apps

Because these free games are custom-made for special schools, Windows might occasionally show a blue "**Windows protected your PC**" or "**SmartScreen**" warning when you try to open them.

Don't worry! The files are completely safe. Follow these simple steps to get the game up and running in less than 30 seconds:

Step 1: "Unblock" the folder before opening it

1. Find the downloaded **ZIP folder** on your computer.
2. **Right-click** on the ZIP folder and choose **Properties** (at the very bottom of the menu).
3. Look at the bottom of the window that pops up. If you see a security note, tick the **Unblock** box.
4. Click **Apply**, then click **OK**.
5. Now, double-click the ZIP folder to extract and open your game!

Step 2: If you still see the Blue Warning Screen...

If you click the game .exe file and a blue window pops up blocking the app:

1. Click the small, underlined "**More info**" text near the top of the warning text.
2. A new button will magically appear at the bottom of the window labeled "**Run anyway**".
3. Click **Run anyway**, and your game will open perfectly.

Note: You will only have to do this the very first time you open a new game on that computer!
